CROP is the name given to community fund-raising events sponsored by Church World

Service (CWS), an international relief, development, and refugee resettlement agency. Money raised by CROP Walks nationwide is used by CWS to provide food, medical care, disaster relief and self-help development efforts for needy people throughout the world.

JOIN US!

To participate in the 2006 CROP Walk, contact your church or service organization. The recruiter there will provide you with a CROP Walker Envelope and additional information. Ask family, friends and group members to sponsor you with a generous donation.

Following the CROP Walk, each participant should turn in their CROP Walker Envelope with the funds raised to their recruiter within two weeks.

RAISE FUNDS ONLINE

Here's an easy way to increase your CROP Walk fund-raising. Go to www.cropwalk.org and click on the online CROP Walker button. Click on Michigan on the U.S. Map that comes up. Scroll down the list of CROP Walks to the (name of your Walk), click on it and follow the directions. You can email family and friends anywhere in the world to help you end hunger and poverty.

HOW FUNDS ARE USED LOCALLY

Twenty-five percent of the money raised in our CROP Walk is distributed to local hunger-alleviating agencies in (the area where your Walk occurs). These are the agencies chosen by the local CROP Walk Planning Team to receive funds this year:
